- Only approved firearm types and calibres may be used, with safe backdrops and containment measures mandatory.
- Culling must occur outside public access hours and is prohibited during school or community sporting events.
- All actions must comply with the Animal Welfare Act 2002, DBCA licence conditions, and occupational safety requirements.
