Appointees must act with full understanding of the legislation, licence conditions, and policy requirements relevant to this authorisation.</p> <p>The Chief Executive Officer is authorised to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Implement Policy 4.10 - Corella Culling Policy.</li> <li>- Approve the timing, location, and scope of authorised culling activities.</li> <li>- Engage licensed external contractors/shooting clubs to undertake culling, with all operational activities, permits, safety management, insurance, and outcomes the responsibility of those contractors.</li> <li>- Ensure copies of all relevant permits, licences, and insurances are provided to the Shire prior to operations.</li> <li>- Liaise with local Police and undertake community notification where practical prior to scheduled shooting.</li> <li>- Maintain post-operation records, including numbers removed, methods used, compliance confirmations, and licence details.</li> <li>- Assign operational responsibilities for implementation of this Policy to the Manager Infrastructure and Projects.</li> </ul>

Conditions on this Authorisation or Appointment:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All culling must be conducted by licensed operators holding current authorisations under the Firearms Act 1973 and permits under the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016.</li> <li>- Only approved firearm types and calibres may be used, with safe backdrops and containment measures mandatory.</li> <li>- Culling must occur outside public access hours and is prohibited during school or community sporting events.</li> <li>- All actions must comply with the Animal Welfare Act 2002, DBCA licence conditions, and occupational safety requirements.</li> </ul>
